

LITTER BAG CRAFT (UPCYCLED TSHIRT)



Supplies:

- T-shirts you don't wear anymore
- Scissors
- Large bowl
- Marker

Step 1:

If you want the design on the t-shirt to show when you're done, start with the t-shirt turned inside out. Lay it out flat with the neck pointed toward you.

Step 2:

Lay the bowl down over the neckline as low or high as you want the opening of the bag to be. Run the marker along the perimeter of the bowl to make cutting easy. Cut on the line you drew along the neckline.

Step 3:

For the straps of the bag, cut down from the top of the shoulders of the t-shirt down toward the bottom of the armpit of the shirt, moving closer to the arm as you go.

Step 4:

Cut a strip of fabric off the bottom of the t-shirt. Gather the bottom of the shirt and tie a portion of the fabric you cut off it (like ribbon), knotting it several times (alternating sides), and trimming the ends of the fabric "ribbon" when you're done.

Step 5:

Turn the bag right side out. Ta-da! Decorate however you like. Use this bag to collect litter when you are out and about.
